## CLASSIC FLIGHT

### Part I: Leaving from Pisco Airport.

At the designated time, our team will pick you up from your hotel in Paracas and transfer you to the nearby Pisco airport. Upon arrival, we will provide detailed information about the air tour's dynamics. Unlike the small aircraft at the Nazca airport, we use a Cessna Caravan plane in Pisco. This plane comfortably seats up to 12 passengers, ensuring that everyone has a window seat.

Before takeoff, our pilot will give each participant a map of the Nazca Lines. This map outlines the circuit we'll follow, making it easy for you to locate the figures on the ground. As we take off, we'll first fly over the deserts of Pisco and Ica before reaching the mysterious desert of Nazca, where the adventure truly begins.

### Part II: Over the Nazca Plateau.

In order to start with the flight circuit, we must start from the figure of the whale.

Once near the zone of the whale figure, the pilot will start to fly in circle over it.

Here you will catch a glance of the whale, etched perfectly inside a huge rectangle.

This marine creature measures about 65 meters in length, and symbolize water.

After that we continue to west where will see huge tringle forms, some of them over 2 km long.

According to the Swiss writer Erick von Daniken these shapes were made by aliens.

He belives these shapes are the result of landings of extraterrestrial ships.

Nearby, we can see also a small hill with a triangle figure on it, with 3 emergin lines.

Later on we will reach the Pampas of Jumana, a zone with the greatest proliferation of figures.

### Part III: Over the Pampa of Jumana.

As we fly over the Jumana desert, we encounter numerous geoglyphs. First, we spot the mysterious Owl-man, also known as the Astronaut. This figure, with its large head and rounded eyes, stands 35 meters tall. Unlike other geoglyphs, the Owl-man sits on a hillside, which makes it unique.

Continuing west, we discover the figure of a fox, followed by a large monkey, both meticulously crafted. Next, in one corner of the Pampas of Jumana, we come across the Hummingbird. This geoglyph is not only one of the most striking but also remarkably well-preserved, capturing the attention of all who see it. A short distance away, we reach the figure of the Spider. Discovered in 1946, this geoglyph continues to fascinate visitors with its precise lines and intricate design. Nearby, we find a massive Condor, which stretches approximately 120 meters in length, impressing everyone with its sheer size.

As our journey continues, we fly over the Pampas of San Jose, approaching the Ingenio Valley. Here, the landscape reveals even more ancient mysteries, each geoglyph telling a story etched into the earth by ancient hands.

## **Part IV: Over the Pampa of San Jose.**

The Pampa of San Jose shelters an amazing group of geoglyphs. Among them, you'll spot a heron, a massive figure stretching as long as three soccer fields. Additionally, the parrot figure stands out, with its head and beak clearly visible from the air. Moving along the Panamerican Highway, you'll notice the figures of the hands and the tree. Just a few meters away lies the large Lizard figure, measuring around 180 meters.

Unfortunately, when authorities built the highway through this area long ago, they nearly destroyed the Lizard. However, you can still see its entire form from above. Next, we will fly over the Ingenio Valley and continue towards the Palpa region, where more wonders await.

## **Part V: Over the Palpa Desert.**

The desert of palpa has a large number of geoglyphs, most of them human figures. Scholars believe the geoglyphs of Palpa are much older than those found in the Nazca region.

Most the figures etched in Palpa are attributed to the Paracas people, who thrived around 500 BC.

Unlike the drawings of Nazca, in Palpa most the human representations are found on hillsides.

During the flight we will see a group of human beings known as the Royal Family. On the other hand, we will also see enormous trapezoids built onto the flat mountains of Palpa.

After having seen all the geoglyphs in the Palpa area, we will return to the Pisco airport. Eventually, our driver will take you back to your hotel. End of our service.

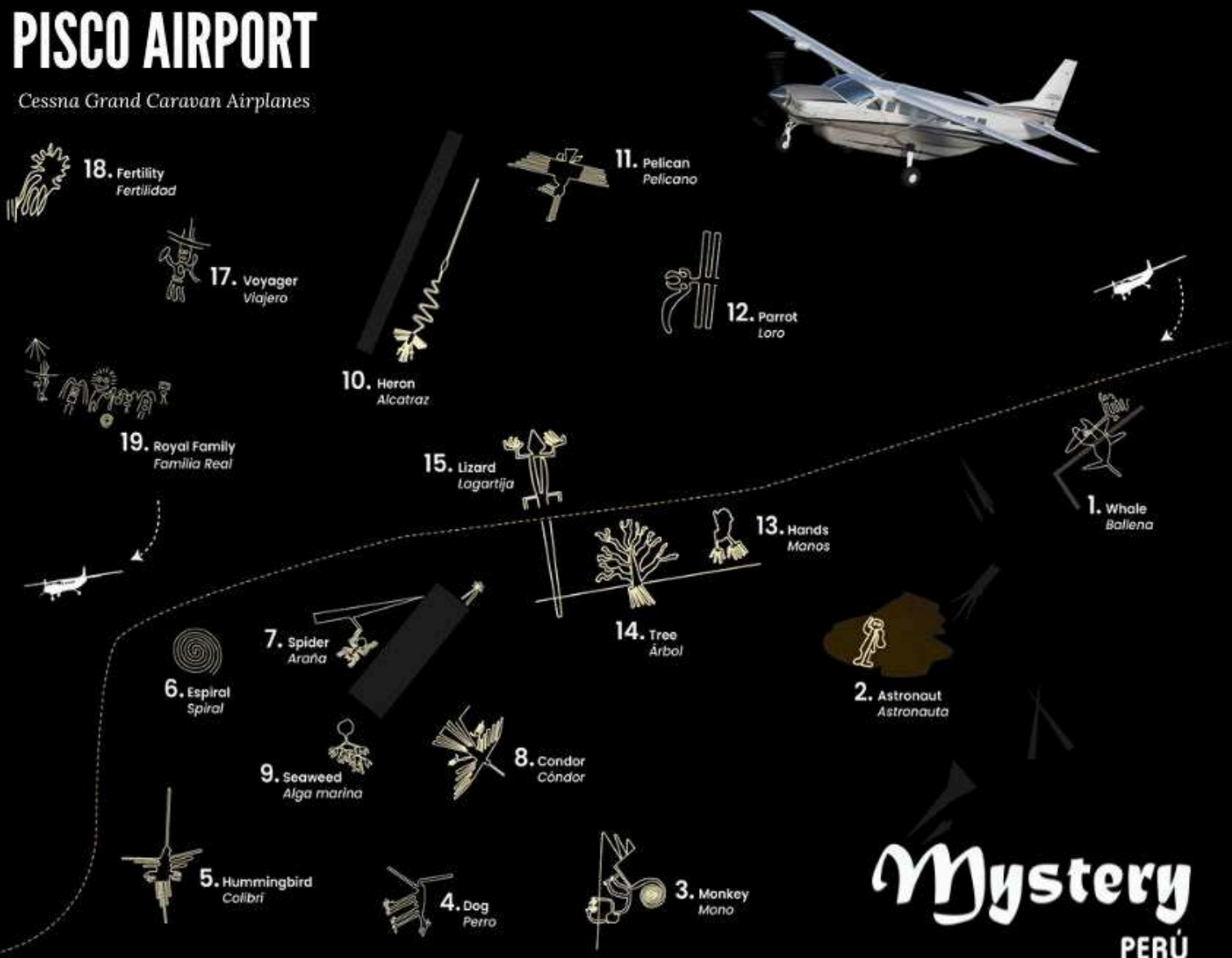
