Travel across a surreal desert landscape in a powerful 4x4, where dry hills and red sands stretch like a Martian world. After two hours of thrilling off-road adventure, the Pacific suddenly appears, a striking contrast of wild ocean meeting lifeless land.



“TRACK THE ELUSIVE GUANACOS IN THE WILD”

One of the few places in Peru to see wild guanacos! These elegant camelids roam freely in the high desert cliffs above the bay, offering a rare sighting of a species once sacred to ancient Andean cultures.



“FIND PENGUINS WHERE YOU LEAST EXPECT THEM”

Discover the unexpected: penguins in the tropics! Along rocky outcrops near the bay, you'll find Humboldt penguins living far from icy shores, nesting among coastal caves and sunlit cliffs.



“SOAR WITH CONDORS ABOVE A LIVING COASTLINE”

San Fernando is a birdwatcher's paradise. Observe majestic condors circling overhead, alongside flocks of pelicans, boobies, cormorants, and graceful Inca terns gliding above the waves and rocky islands.

TOUR DESCRIPTION

Part I: 4×4 Expedition Across the Desert

Your Tour to San Fernando Bay begins at 08:30 h with hotel pickup in Nazca. The journey kicks off aboard a 4×4 vehicle, ideal for traversing the desolate beauty of the coastal desert. The landscape is surreal — endless red hills and cracked earth that resemble the surface of Mars. Along the way, your naturalist guide shares insights into the region's geology, flora, and the rare wildlife that survives in this dry terrain. If lucky, you might even spot wild guanacos roaming the hills.

Part II: Arrival at the Pacific Coast & Wildlife Encounters

After roughly 2 hours of off-road adventure, the desert suddenly gives way to the deep blue of the Pacific Ocean. At El Mirador, a scenic viewpoint, you'll capture sweeping panoramas of San Fernando Bay — a remote and peaceful marine sanctuary.

From here, a short walk leads you down to the bay, where sea lions rest on rocky shores and Humboldt penguins waddle along the coastline. You'll also see pelicans, cormorants, Inca terns, and possibly condors soaring above the cliffs.

Part III: Exploration of the Natural Island & Beach Break

You'll continue on foot across a rocky beach toward a natural island platform, home to nesting seabirds and dramatic rock formations. The guide will point out areas where penguins and other rare species often hide. After time to explore and enjoy the island views, you'll return to the beach to rest, have lunch, or even swim in the cold but refreshing waters of San Fernando. Before heading back, you'll visit another part of the bay where hundreds of sea lions gather along the shoreline, an unforgettable farewell. The tour ends in Nazca around 16:00 h.
